In the fall of 2017, the SD 4 School Board initiated a long-term goal setting process. They identified the goal of bringing learning spaces to modern standards in order to improve the learning environment for students and staff. Improvements to Ardmore Elementary School are among the initiatives the District is undertaking. Ardmore houses two elements: one half is elementary school and the other half is the Early Learning Center offering kindergarten and preschool programs. ICI was retained as construction manager to complete two single-story additions totaling 7,400 square feet and 2,500 square feet of interior remodeling to the existing building.

The ELC addition contains four classrooms, four student restrooms, two integrated therapy rooms and a staff breakroom with its own restrooms and laundry room. This addition will be heated through radiant floor slab heating. The elementary school addition includes two offices, a conference room and a nurse's office. Construction began in March 2020 and will complete August 2020.
